Lake of the Woods District Hospital

- Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH) is a 77-bed acute care hospital in Kenora, Ontario, located on Lake of the Woods.
- Staffed by a dedicated team, LWDH provides patient-centered care to local residents, nearby communities, and seasonal visitors
- Accredited with Exemplary Standing by Accreditation Canada.
- Emergency Department (ED) operates 24/7 and includes a Nurse Practitioner (NP) Service (since 2023) to manage seasonal surges and reduce wait times.
- Outpatient services include:
 - Rehabilitation, dialysis, chemotherapy, surgical services
 - Diagnostic Imaging Centre of Excellence with nine gold standard modalities
 - Visiting specialists & Mental Health & Addictions programming
- 24-hour air ambulance and medical transport by Ornge
- A new hospital is being planned in partnership with Ogimaawabiitong Kenora Chiefs Advisory, Ontario Ministry of Health, and local communities.
- Population served: ~35,000 year-round (including 10 First Nations and rural communities), growing to 70,000+ in summer months due to tourism and seasonal residents.
